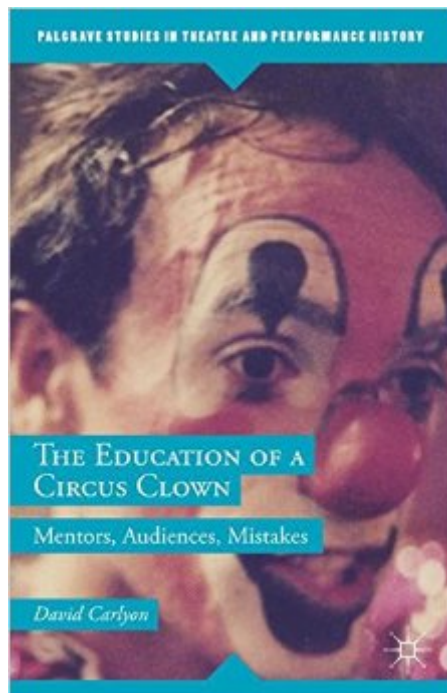

Dave is quite the Renaissance man: writer, teacher, historian, actor, lawyer (!) and, last but not least, clown. His narrative of attending Clown College (1976) and touring with the Blue Unit (1977) stands above most circus memoirs not just because heâ™s a better writer â™itâ™s a good readâ™ but because he actually focuses on the performerâ™s struggles to stay vibrant and funny from day to day, audience to audience.
